The May 18 meeting of the Lake Wylie Marine Commission was scheduled to be held at the Red Fez Shrine Club in Mecklenburg County as per the normal county rotation. The advisory issued by North Carolina Attorney General Josh Stein's office states that local governments are encouraged to postpone meetings that are not necessary for immediate ongoing governance. On this basis we are cancelling the May 18 meeting and will defer the agenda to the June meeting.
